

GOING GREEN COMMITTEE CHARTER

Reviewed/Revised 2011

The Going Green Committee is established to research, study and discuss ways to save energy and resources, save money and protect the environment for both the HOA and individual homes.

The Committee will consist of a minimum of 5 members with the chairperson to determine the needed final number. The Committee will select a chairperson and an assistant chairperson. The members shall serve at the discretion of the Board, and will be reviewed yearly.

Term: Members 1 year 3/1 to 2/28/29

Chairperson 2 years 3/1 to 2/28/29

Duties: Recommended, but not limited to:

- Research ideas on what companies and other similar organizations are doing to 'go green'
- Learn the current practices and operation of SunBird relating to these areas.
- Create a list of ideas with plans on how to implement and carry out these ideas. List the benefits, savings, expense, and if any, potential risks or problems.
- Report findings to the Board of Directors.
- Maintain minutes of all meetings and distribute copies to the Board.
